Thorndon Woodland Management 2025/2026


Q Is my visit to Thorndon Country Park likely to be affected?

A Woodland Work is taking place in Mill Wood at Thorndon South.

Some permissive routes through the wood could be impacted, and you may see and hear large machinery

Part of the car park will be closed for timber storage. Large vehicles may be using the main track from the wood to the car park, where timber will be stored.

Diversions will be in place.



Q Will I need to keep my dog on the lead?

A Yes, please keep dogs on leads in any areas where work is taking place for their safety and that of the workers. Please observe and follow any safety signs.

Q How long will the work be taking place?

A These works are likely to take place over a few weeks.

The ambitious landscape restoration programme at the Essex Country Parks will be taking place over many years to boost nature recovery for the future.

At Thorndon this will mean further woodland and wood pasture work. As well as grassland restoration and grazing, fencing is going up to protect the livestock.
